### **GEORGIA INTERNATIONAL HORSE PARK**

This is the Georgia International Horse Park. And from the beginning, it has been groomed for greatness. Since opening its gates in September of 1995, the GIHP has already served as the equestrian venue for the largest sporting event in the world: The 1996 Centennial Olympic Games. The park was the setting for all equestrian events, as well as the first ever mountain bike competition and the final two events of the modern pentathlon of the 1996 Centennial Olympic Games.

Today, the tradition continues as the GIHP plays host to a remarkable variety of special events. Whether you are planning an equestrian competition, festival, concert, wedding reception, family reunion or sports competition, the park's sprawling 1,400 acres can accommodate events of all shapes and sizes.

We have seven parking lots that can accommodate a total of 6,500 cars. Carefully planned for large crowds, our convenient parking lots are spacious, easily accessible and able to utilize shuttle services.

We've been told by many of our visitors that the Georgia International Horse Park is one of the best kept secrets that they have found with regard to RV parks east of Atlanta. The GIHP offers a full-service RV park for the convenience of our guests. Fully equipped with water, electric and sewer service, these 140+ sites are located near the Stable Complex and the Walker Arena Complex. Full-service shower facilities are also located within the RV Park and their use is included in the daily RV site rental fee. Due to limited capacity, you must call in advance (770-860-4190) and reserve your space. GIHP office hours are Monday-Friday, 8:00 a.m. – 5 p.m. We look forward to your visit!

Free Wi-Fi connectivity is available while visiting the Georgia International Horse Park. Connectivity is available throughout the equine core. Enjoy staying in touch with your friends, business associates, etc., while visiting the Horse Park. 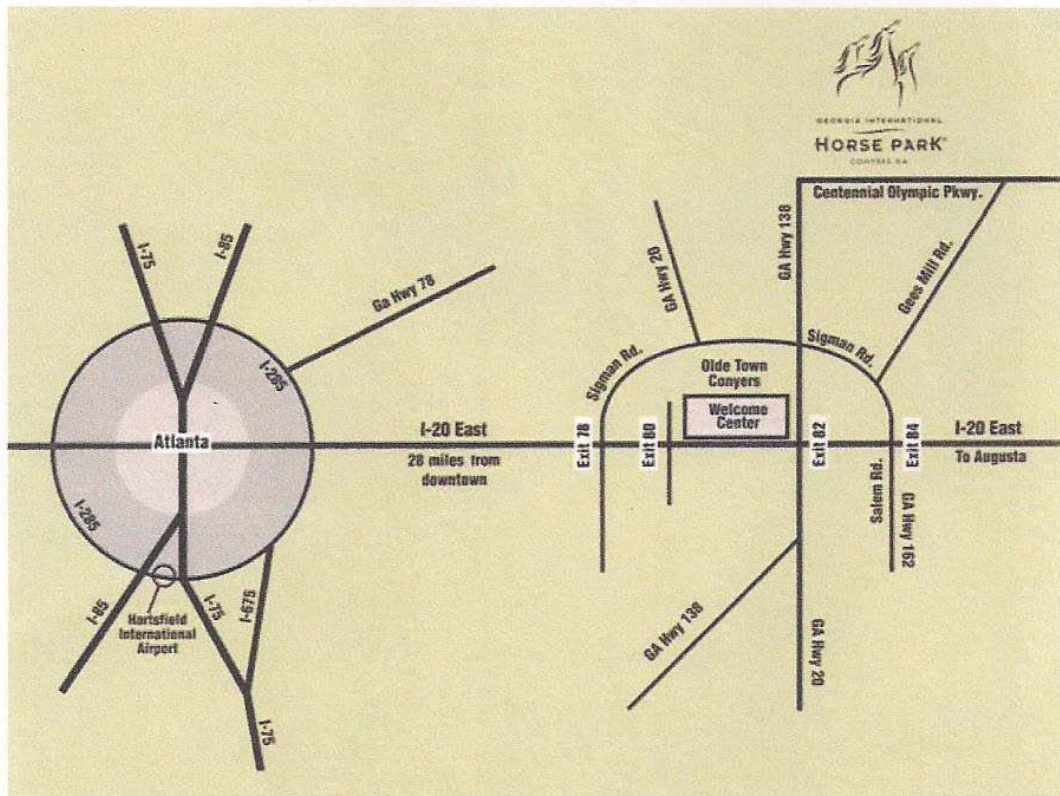
## ROUTES TO TRIAL

The Georgia International Horse Park is located just 28 miles from the city of Atlanta.

Take Exit 82 off Interstate 20 in Conyers. Travel North approximately 4 miles. Turn right onto Centennial Olympic Parkway. The main entrance to the Park is 2 miles ahead on the right.

An alternative route to the Park is via Salem Road (Exit 84) off Interstate 20. Take Exit 84 and travel North approximately 1 mile. At Gees Mill Road, turn right and the Georgia International Horse Park Gate A is 2.5 miles on the right. To continue to the main gate (Gate C), continue past Gate A and turn right into Centennial Olympic Parkway. The main entrance will be on your right.

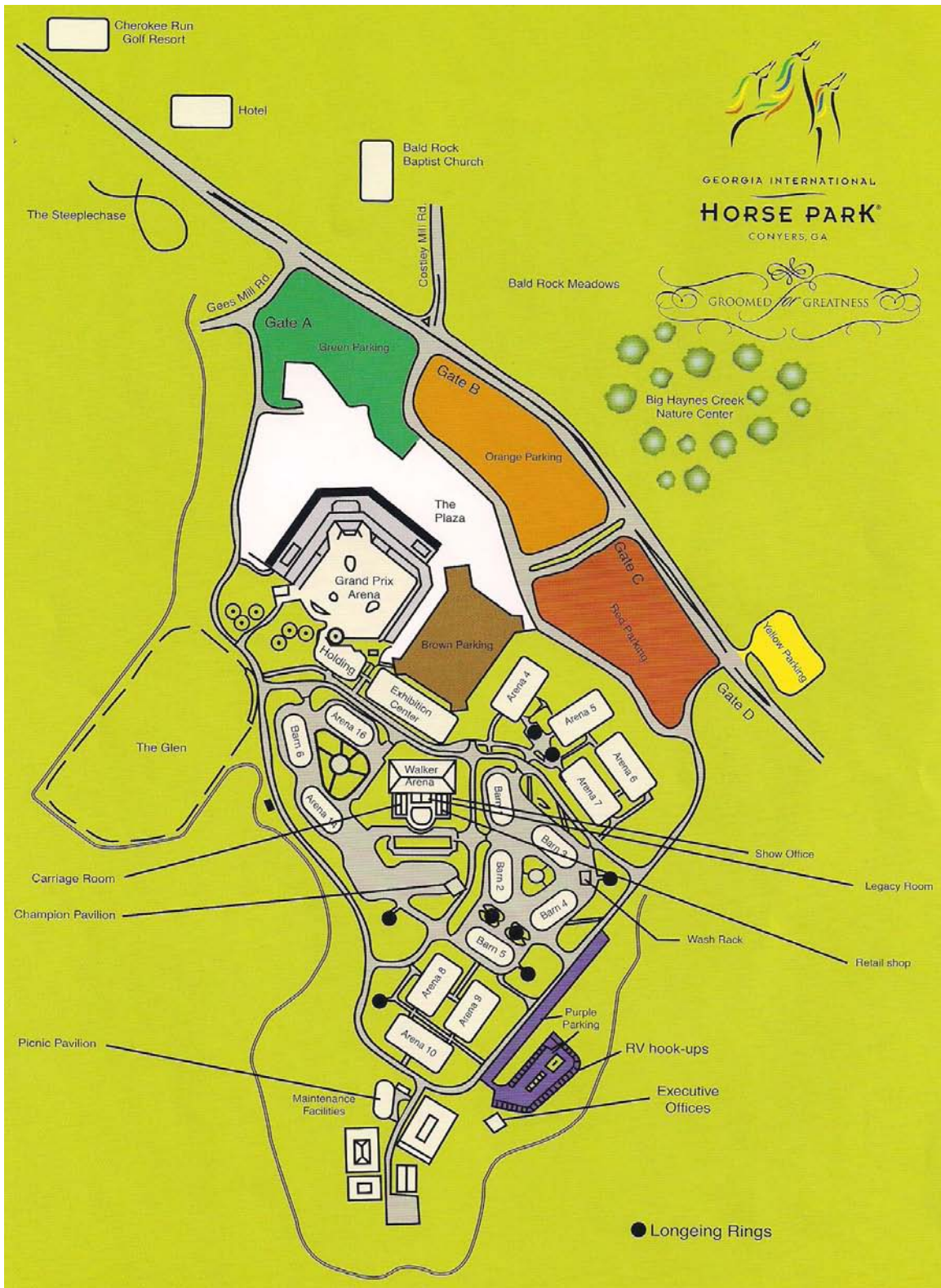
## PARKING AND HORSE PARK DETAIL MAP

**UPDATED RV INFORMATION: As of Saturday, September 10: IMPORTANT FOR RVers... Because of a horse show going on at the Park the weekend of September 24/25, we need to limit the number of RVs arriving on Saturday. To be safe, please plan to arrive in your RV AFTER 4:00 PM on Sunday, September 25, or, better yet, on Monday morning.**

### **Parking and RVs**

- ~~RV parking will become available at 9AM on Saturday, September 24, 2011.~~ Please see info above. All RVs must vacate the site by noon, Sunday, October 2. The fee for parking is \$225 for the entire Specialty.
- RV parking will be primarily on gravel surfaces. Most hookups include electricity; however extension cords may be required for connection. Water will be available; however "Y" connections and extra hose may be required. Very few sites will include sewer, however some sites will require a long sewer hose to connect. Septic pump-out will be arranged for a mid-week service, payment will be made directly to the service provider by the RV user at the time of the service. Additional information and sign-up will be available after arrival. A dump station is available at the facility; however please arrive with empty tanks if at all possible.
- Each RV will have an assigned space, RV parking will be limited to the spaces reserved, with no day-use RV parking available.
- Please arrive between the hours of 9AM and 9PM to ensure assistance in finding your assigned space. A map of assigned spaces will be made available for early or late arrivals, however anyone parking in an incorrect space will be asked to move.
- Confirmations will be sent via email only. Date received will be tracked to ensure special requests are met whenever possible.
- Reservations may be cancelled without penalty through August 15, 2011. No refunds will be available after that date. Please use email to cancel any confirmed reservation.

- There are approximately 100 RV spaces available at the facility. A waiting list will be maintained should more requests be received than can be immediately filled. Notification of waiting list status will be sent as soon as it is determined. Final determination of site availability will be made between August 15 and September 1. Refunds for reservations that cannot be accommodated will be processed after September 1.
