## **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

**ENTRIES:** Telegraph, telephone and fax entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on **Official AKC Entry Forms** without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the form are not acceptable. **Unsigned Entry Forms cannot be accepted.** Entry Forms **MUST** be filled out completely. Incomplete entries do not constitute a valid entry. Owners are responsible for errors made on their completed entry forms. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors, or cancellation of entries, after published closing date. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature. **Maximum of 10 dogs per envelope for mailed entries. No hand deliveries within the first 24 hours of the trial opening. PLEASE PRINT OR TYPE CLEARLY! ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES** will be mailed as soon as practicable after trial closes, and will include confirmation notices and judging schedule.

**MOVE-UPS:** Dogs may be moved up at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title; provided that the request is made to **the Trial Secretary in writing** (E-Mail is acceptable.) Day-to Day move-ups will be accepted, provided the Trial Secretary receives them within 15 minutes after the end of the last class from the AGRC trial held on September 26, 2011.

**ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check. Checks should be made payable to **2011 GRCA National Specialty Entry fee:** 1ST ENTRY OF EACH DOG \$40.00, 2ND ENTRY OF SAME DOG \$25.00, 3RD ENTRY OF SAME DOG \$15.00 (Includes all applicable AKC recording fees).

**BITCHES IN SEASON** are not eligible to participate. There will be a refund of entries due to bitches which come in season after trial has closed, provided that the owner gives notice in writing to the trial secretary before start of the trial.

**THE SAFETY OF DOGS** is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. **Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.**

**ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR IN THE DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREA.** Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **All exhibitors must pick up dog**

**waste everywhere on the show grounds.** The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made.

**JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS.** The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. If handlers have a ring conflict and so inform the gate steward, every effort will be made to accommodate you.

**THE GOLDEN RETRIEVER CLUB OF AMERICA,** its trial committee and its agents, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

**OBSTACLES:** Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations For Agility Trials. Agility equipment will be provided by Max 200 with rubberized contacts and 24" weave pole spacing. Ring size is a minimum of 100' X 110'. ELECTRONIC TIMERS may be used for all classes

### **DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER – Golden Retrievers Only**

This trial is open to all Golden Retrievers 15 months and older that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or that have obtained an AKC ILP/PAL number. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

### **HEIGHT DIVISIONS:**

Exhibitors are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. In the Regular classes, dogs may be entered at the jump height for which their measurement qualifies them or a higher jump height, if the exhibitor chooses. In the Preferred classes, however, dogs must run in the jump height for which their actual measurement qualifies them.

**Crating Space:** The trial site is on grass with plenty of space. Crates and tents may be left over night, however, the GRCA and the Georgia International Horse Park will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

**Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s).** Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without the benefit of a refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

**RV Parking:** RV Parking (Dry Camping Only) will be available at “The Glen” for the agility trial. The fee will be \$50.00 for 3 nights beginning Sunday (9/25) and ending Wednesday morning. ## **DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL:**

The Georgia International Horse Park is located just 28 miles from the city of Atlanta.

Take Exit 82 off Interstate 20 in Conyers. Travel North approximately 4 miles. Turn right onto Centennial Olympic Parkway. The main entrance to the Park is 2 miles ahead on the right.

An alternative route to the Park is via Salem Road (Exit 84) off Interstate 20. Take Exit 84 and travel North approximately 1 mile. At Gees Mill Road, turn right and the Georgia International Horse Park Gate A is 2.5 miles on the right. To continue to the main gate (Gate C), continue past Gate A and turn right into Centennial Olympic Parkway. The main entrance will be on your right.

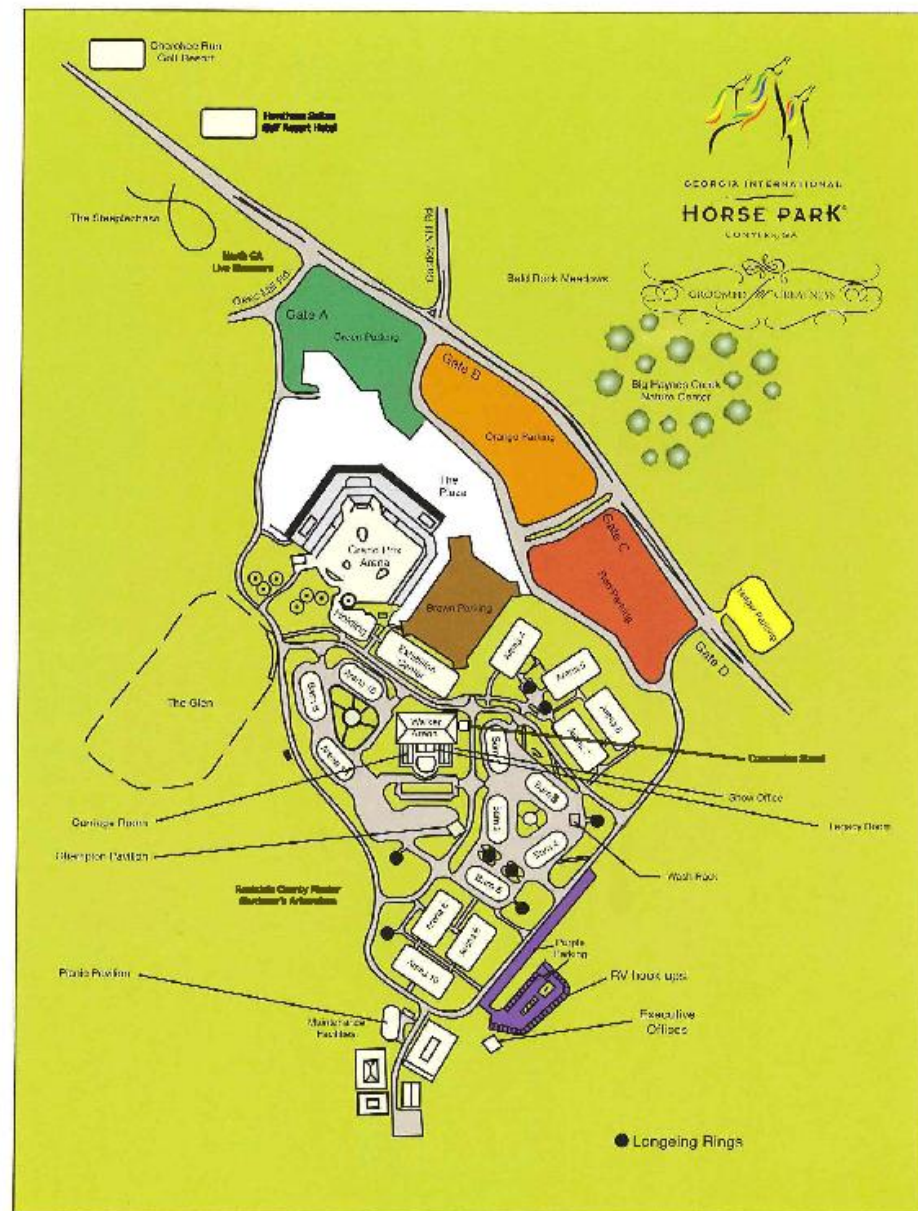

## 2011 GRCA National Specialty Top Agility Golden (TAG)

For the first time in GRCA history, twenty outstanding Golden retrievers competing in agility will be recognized with the presentation of the **2011 GRCA National Specialty Top Agility Golden** (or TAG) awards. The TAG awards will be presented Tuesday, September 27, 2011 prior to the start of the day's agility competitions.

To be considered a Top Agility Golden, the dog must demonstrate not only speed but also consistency. Therefore, in order to be eligible for this honor, a *Golden retriever must first be ranked in the top 50 in both speed points and double q's for 2010*. To be ranked on one list and not the other excludes your dog from this honor. The following formula will be used in determining the Top Agility Golden's:

1. The top 50 Golden Retrievers in speed points and double q's will be determined by downloading the AKC *TopDogs* in Agility/Golden retriever report;
2. These dogs will receive TAG (Top Agility Golden) points based on their individual rankings in speed points and double q's. (i.e., A dog in 3rd place in the national rankings will receive 3 TAG points, 10th place will receive 10 TAG points, etc.);
3. TAG points earned by each dog will be combined: TAG/Speed Pts. + TAG/qq's=TAG Total

The 20 Golden retrievers with the *lowest* TAG point total will receive the Top Agility Golden awards.

**Qualifying period for the 2011 GRCA National Specialty TAG awards:**

**September 2010 through July 2011**

Again, to be eligible for this honor, a Golden retriever *must first be ranked in the top 50 in both speed points and double q's for year end 2010* (minimum 817 pts/17 QQ's) and Jan-July 2011.
